Club News and Notes from the Prez, George Hahn

Looking ahead to the fall elections the club has two officer positions to be slated: Vice President and Secretary. We're hoping you will consider serving in one of these roles. Here is what is involved.

Duties of the Vice President:

The by-laws state that "The Vice-President shall act in the absence of the President with all the authority and responsibilities of the presidency".

What isn't in the by-laws is the need for continuity in leadership. To that end, the Vice President must commit to serving as President when the job is next open. Having the next President serving with the other officers and board members keeps club planning and activities consistent even when there is a change in leadership. It also assures we will have leaders and that the club will not fail due to lack of involvement by members.

Duties of the TBCR Secretary:

The by-laws state that "The Secretary shall keep accurate minutes of all meetings, maintain a current membership list, and such duties as may be assigned by the club".

The specifics of the job include:

- Prepare minutes of three meetings: Board meeting, members meeting and election at the Hot Dog Run.
- Maintain the official club bylaws.
- Help the President coordinate informal board votes as needed.
- Coordinate the list of members with the Treasurer and maintain the Directory.
- Maintain the MailChimp email list.

Both positions serve on the TBCR Board.

As many of you know, an active and successful British Car Club in a nearby city had to close down last year when no one was willing to assume responsibility for club leadership. This was a grim reminder for me of how important it is for club members to do more than show up – active participation is the lifeblood of our club. I hope you will consider these opportunities and remember the words of John Bull.....




Scenes from the latest Little Anthony's show. The second this year featuring TBCR. 17 TBCR cars were displayed on a perfect evening.

Jeff Lilley's 1948 MGTC took the top prize among sports cars.


