

#### **BONUS DRIVE Last Month - 31 AUGUST**

This Drive was so close to the end of the month that it could not be included in the September Newsletter, and it appears that photography was prohibited for some reason.



- Exit east [R] on Broadway Blvd
- Go south [R] on Freeman Rd
- Go east [L] on Old Spanish Trail watch for cyclists and walkers
- Go east [L] at the light at Valencia Rd to stay on Old Spanish Trail
- Go south [R] on Pistol Hill Rd
- Go east [L] on Colossal Cave Rd watch for the sign, so you won't miss it
- Go east on Colossal Cave Rd to the roundabout and return to Pistol Hill Rd
- Go south [L] on Pistol Hill Rd which will be now Colossal Cave Rd toward Vail
- Go south [L] at the light at Walgreen's to stay on Colossal Cave Rd through Vail
- Continue south through Vail and over I-10, as it becomes Wentworth Rd
- Go west [R] on Sahuarita Rd and continue for approx. 18 miles
- Go north [R] on Nogales Hwy
- Go west [L] on Pima Mine Rd there is a light and turn lane
- Go approximately 3.2 miles and make a RIGHT turn into Desert Diamond Casino
- Park, enter, order and EAT!!!
- ENJOY!!!!

# <u>1<sup>st</sup> DRIVE – 07 SEPTEMBER – Starbucks Grove and La Cholla Circle K on S Palo</u> Verde Rd Westward Ho through the Tucson Mountains.

Beautiful weather - not too hot. A feeling that summer is over. And there was a decent turnout of drivers.


















1<sup>st</sup> Drive – SATURDAY – 07 Sept – 7:00 AM departure -Starbucks at La Cholla and Orange Grove North side loop up toward Dove Mountain and back to Beyond Bread at Ina Rd & Oracle Rd



- Exit south [R] on La Cholla Blvd
- Go west [R] on River Rd
- Go north [R] on Shannon Rd and job left and right to stay north on Shannon Rd
- Go west [L] on Magee Rd and straight as it becomes westbound Cortaro Farms Rd
- Go north [R] toward entrance ramp to I-10 but STAY RIGHT to be on the Frontage Rd
- Go northeast [R] on Twin Peaks Rd
- Twin Peaks Rd becomes Dove Mountain Rd as it crosses Tangerine Rd
- Go east [R] on Moore Rd (the first sign for Moore Rd is to the west ignore)
- Continue over the lovely desert terrain, hopefully with few cars
- Go south [R] on La Cañada Dr
- Go east [L] on Ina Rd and stay to the right as you approach Oracle Rd
- Beyond Bread in on the SE corner at the first entrance to the parking lot.
- ENJOY!!!

<u>**2<sup>nd</sup>** DRIVE – 21 SEPTEMBER – Circle K on Palo Verde to the Northwest with Breakfast at Old Time Kafe.</u>

Great weather; a great route combining S. Kinney Rd and Gates Pass; and a great breakfast at a great restaurant. They were ready for us at Old Time Kafe providing a huge room to accommodate our large group (it was actually reserved for another group to arrive shortly after our departure.)







- Pass Ajo Way (SR86) and Old Tucson Studios
- Go east [R] on Gates Pass Rd and go up, up, up
- Go north [L] on Camion de Oeste and enjoy the roller coaster ride
- Follow Camino de Oeste to the east as it becomes Sweetwater Dr
- Go north [L] on Silverbell Rd
- Go east [R] on Camino del Cerro
- Go south [R] toward the on ramp to I-10 east Tucson
- STAY RIGHT to be on Frontage Rd
- Go east [L] on W. Prince Rd
- Cross Romero Rd and go right at 1485 W. Prince Rd for the Old Time Kafe...
- Enjoy!!!




