NOTICE OF CHANGE:

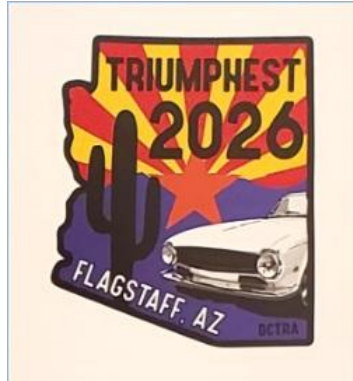
We have been informed by the organizer that they will no longer allow clubs to make substitutions for their members who cancel. Late registrations will go on the wait list.
